



## MyBlogLog.com Widget Setup

Register at [www.mybloglog.com](http://www.mybloglog.com). You can create your profile and add the blog, or blogs, you author. However, this “how to” will focus on creating the widget that shows the people who have visited your blog.

It's also a social networking site, allowing you to meet other bloggers and expand your sphere of influence. If you have a business that you can market over the internet, this is another great place to meet people. It also gives your visitors one more thing to look at, keeping them at your site a little longer!

Once you register, log in to MyBlogLog and go to “My Home” You are looking for the “Get Widgets” button (outlined in blue). Tap that button.

What we are creating with this “widget” is the Recent Readers column you see outlined in blue on the lower right.

You’ll tap the `c_color_whatever` and then pick a color with your mouse cursor. Tap on the next `c_color_whatever` and pick it’s color with your mouse cursor. You can play with the width by changing the number in the px box.

Choose if you want the screen names to show, what size you want the images, and how many rows of readers you want to show. You can title it anything you want, Recent Readers, Blog Buddies, Friends, etc.

Then tap the “Preview and Get Code (outlined in red) to get the next screen.



If you have a Blogger blog, copy this code, log in to Blogger.com and go to your layout. You'll be adding an HTML/JavaScript Page Element. Open the element, paste the code in it, and make sure to give it a title.

If you have the WordPress.org software installed on your domain, like [www.northsandiegobusiness.com](http://www.northsandiegobusiness.com), you log in to the Dashboard, to Presentation, to Widgets and add a text widget. Paste the code in and give your text widget a name. I used Recent Readers on mine.

If you are at WordPress.com you won't be able to use this feature. Sorry ;-(
